# EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 010 Series of 2021

# RECONSTITUTING THE ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD (ESWMB) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF MARCOS, ILOCOS NORTE

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 enjoins LGUs to enforce sanitation laws, prepare solid waste management programs, and other implementing functions;

WHEREAS, Presidential Decree No. 1152 otherwise known as Philippine Environmental Code of 1997 established specific environmental management policies and prescribed environmental quality standards for air and water, land use management, natural resources management and conservation, enforcement and guidelines for waste management programs shall be required in all provinces, cities and municipalities

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 59 of the same R.A. and by virtue of Executive Order No. 192 series of 1987, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources hereby adopts and promulgates the implementing rules and regulations in the management of solid and liquid waste;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Marcos, Ilocos Norte created the Ecological Solid Waste Management Board (ESWMB), emanating from the mandate of R.A. 9003, otherwise known as the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000";

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconstitute the Ecological Solid Waste Management Board of the Local Government of Marcos, Ilocos Norte to update its membership and to replace members who are no longer connected to the LGU.

WHEREFORE, premises considered and by virtue of the powers vested in me under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, I, ANTONIO V. MARIANO, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Marcos, Ilocos Norte, do hereby reconstitute the Ecological Solid Waste Management Board (ESWMB) of the Local Government Unit of Marcos, Ilocos Norte and order the following:

#### Section 2. Functions. The EWSMB shall have the following functions:

- 1. Adopt measures to promote and ensure the viability and effective implementation of solid waste management programs in the barangays;
- 2. Monitor the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan through its various political subdivisions and in cooperation with the private sector and the NGOs;
- 3. Adopt specific revenue-generating measure to promote the viability of its Solid Waste Management Plan;
- 4. Convene regular meetings for purposes of planning and coordinating the implementation of the solid waste management plans of the barangays;
- 5. Oversee the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan;
- 6. Review every two (2) year or as the need arises the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan for purposes of ensuring its sustainability, viability, effectiveness and relevance in relation to local and international developments in the filed of solid waste management;
- 7. Develop the specific mechanics and guidelines for the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan;
- 8. Recommend to appropriate local government authorities' specific measure or proposals for franchise or build-operate-transfer agreements with duly recognized institutions, pursuant to RA 6967, to provide either exclusive or non-exclusive authority for the collection, transfer, storage, processing, recycling or disposal of municipal solid waste. The proposals shall take into consideration appropriate government rules and regulations on contracts, franchise and build-operate-transfer agreements;
- 9. Provide the necessary logistical and operational support in consonance with subsection (f) of Section 17 of the Local Government Code;
- 10. Recommend measures and safeguards against pollution and for the perservation of the natural ecosystem;
- 11. Coordinate the efforts of the barangays in the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan;

**Section 3.** Repealing Clause. All executive orders, proclamations, rules, regulations, previous issuances or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
