2. Extend the necessary assistance to the LDRMM Council during disasters.
3. Perform such other functions as may be required by law and other related issuances.

**Section 4. BENEFITS AND PROTECTION OF MEMBERS.** Any member who incurs death and injury while engaged of official response and operation shall be entitled to individual personnel accident insurance.

**Section 10. EFFECTIVITY.** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.

**AN ORDER CREATING THE MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM OF MARCOS, ILOCOS NORTE, DEFINING ITS DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES.**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 10121 states that it shall be the policy of the state, among others, “to uphold the people’s constitutional rights to life and property by addressing the causes of vulnerabilities to disasters, strengthening the country’s institutional capacity for disaster risk reduction and management and building the resilience of local communities to disaster including climate change impacts”;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to establish a response team in the Municipality to readily address emergency situations and give assistance during calamities brought about by natural and manmade disasters;

**WHEREAS**, it is essential to institutionalize the response team of the Municipality in order to efficiently serve the population especially during crisis;

**NOW THEREFORE**, premises considered and by virtue of the powers vested in me under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, I, **ANTONIO V. MARIANO**, Municipal Mayor of Marcos, Ilocos Norte, do hereby create the Municipal Emergency Response Team of Marcos, Ilocos Norte, defining its duties and responsibilities, and order the following:

**Section 1. PURPOSE.** The Executive Order hereby creates the Municipal Emergency Response Team of the Municipality selected from among the local personnel of the LGU purposely to act the quick response arm of the Municipal Government during times of crisis and emergencies. The team shall undergo proper trainings and orientation relevant to its rules and purpose.
