Section 2. FUNCTIONS. The ESWMB shall have the following functions:

 Develop and update the Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP) that will ensure the long-term management of solid waste as well as integrate the various solid waste management plan and strategies of the barangays in the municipality;

Adopt specific revenue generating measures to promote the viability and effectiveness in the implementation of the SWM in component barangays;

 Develop specific mechanics and guidelines for the implementation of the Municipal SWMP;

4. Oversee the implementation of the Local Solid Waste Management;

Review every two (2) years or as the need arises, the SWMP for sustainability, viability, effectiveness and relevance in relation to local and international development in the field of solid waste management;

 Recommend to appropriate local government authorities specific measures or proposal for franchise or build-operate-transfer agreement with duly recognized institutions to provide either exclusive or non-exclusive authority for the collections, transfer, storage, recycling or disposal of solid waste;

 Convene regular meetings for purposes of planning and coordinating the implementation of SMW Plans of the respective component barangays;

 Provide necessary logistical and operational support to component barangays in consonance with Local Government Code;

Recommend measures against pollution and the preservation of the natural of the natural ecosystem;

10. Set guidelines and targets for solid waste avoidance and volume reduction through source reduction and waste minimization measures, including composting, recycling, reuse, recovery, green charcoal process, and others, before collection, treatment and disposal in appropriate and environmentally-sound solid waste management facilities in accordance with ecologically sustainable development principles;


11. Ensure proper segregation, collection, transport, storage, recycling or disposal of solid waste through formulation and adoption of the best environmental practices in the ecological waste management excluding incineration;

12. Recommend to institutionalize the public participation in the development and implementation of the national and local integrated, comprehensive and ecological waste management programs.

Section 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. All executive orders, proclamations, rules, regulations, previous issuances or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 023 Series of 2022

RECONSTITUTING THE ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD (ESWMB) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF MARCOS, ILOCOS NORTE

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 enjoins LGUs to enforce sanitation laws, prepare solid waste management programs, and other implementing functions;

WHEREAS, Presidential Decree No. 1152 otherwise known as Philippine Environmental Code of 1997 established specific environmental management policies and prescribed environmental quality standards for air and water, land use management, natural resources management and conservation, enforcement and guidelines for waste management programs shall be required in all provinces, cities and municipalities;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 59 of the same R.A. and by virtue of Executive Order No. 192 series of 1987, the Department of Environment and Natural Resources hereby adopts and promulgates the implementing rules and regulations in the management of solid and liquid waste;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Marcos, Ilocos Norte created the Ecological Solid Waste Management Board (ESWMB), emanating from the mandate of R.A. 9003, otherwise known as the "Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000";

WHEREAS, there is a need to reconstitute the Ecological Solid Waste Management Board (ESWMB) of the Local Government Unit of Marcos, Ilocos Norte to replace members who no longer represent their office/agency and are no longer connected to the LGU of Marcos;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered and by virtue of the powers vested in me under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, I, ANTONIO V. MARIANO, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Marcos, Ilocos Norte, do hereby reconstitute the Ecological Solid Waste Management Board (ESWMB) of the Local Government Unit of Marcos, Ilocos Norte and order the following:
