SECTION 2. FUNCTIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL CBMS COORDINATING BOARD. The Municipal CBMS Coordinating Board (MCCB) shall perform the following functions:

1. Oversee the implementation of the CBMS operations in the municipality. Report status to the concerned Provincial CBMS Coordinating Board.
2. Resolve issues and concerns encountered in the conduct of CBMSA. For issues that cannot be resolved at the municipality level, escalate to the Provincial CBMS coordinating Board.
3. Facilitate the approval and timely release of funds (if any) and/or other requirements for the conduct of CBMS.
4. Issue communications, directives, instructions, and/or circulars to cooperate, mobilize, and provide support/assistance to the CBMS operations in areas but not limited to the conduct/provision of the following:
 - a. Active participation in coordination meetings and activities;
 - b. Publicity and information campaign for the conduct of CBMS;
 - c. Venue for the training conduct, headquarters for the enumeration personnel, and machine processing;






- d. Transportation facilities for the enumeration personnel, and transport of CBMS forms, supplies, and materials;
 - e. Communication and wireless Internet connection facility;
 - f. Storage area for tablets, forms, and other materials;
 - g. Health and legal services to CBMS personnel; and
 - h. Facilitation of enumeration in government-owned and private institutions, and other hard-to-reach areas.
5. Take up other matters as necessary for the successful conduct of the CBMS.

SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. All Executive Orders or issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed or modifies accordingly.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing hereof.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 026
Series of 2022

AN ORDER ORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL COMMUNITY-BASED MONITORING SYSTEM (CBMS) COORDINATING BOARD OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARCOS, ILOCOS NORTE.

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 11315 otherwise known as Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) Act was enacted on 17 April 2019, institutionalizing the conduct of the CBMS in every city and municipality in the country;

WHEREAS, the CBMS is an organized technology-based system of collecting, processing, and validating necessary disaggregated data that may be used for planning, program implementation, and impact monitoring at the local level while empowering communities to participate in the process;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Act states each city and municipality is the primary data collecting authority within its locality.

WHEREAS, Section 6 of the Act states that the Philippine Statistic Authority (PSA) shall serve as the lead agency in the implementation of the CBMS, and shall monitor the data collection by cities and municipalities to ensure adherence to official concepts, definitions, and standards of poverty statistics;

WHEREAS, Section 14 of the Act provides for the creation of the CBMS Council composed of the PSA, Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), and Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT), to be headed by the PSA, for purposes of achieving secure and efficient data sharing arrangements between and among concerned cities and municipalities and national government agencies to be used for their particular social protection and welfare programs and projects;

WHEREAS, the CBMS Council approves Resolution No. 06, Series of 2021 on the establishment of the Provincial and City/Municipal Coordinating Board that shall be responsible in overseeing the CBMS operations in their respective locality, ensuring logistic and other requirements are in place prior and during the CBMS operations, and resolving issues and concerns encountered in the conduct of CBMS in their jurisdiction;

NOW THEREFORE, premises considered and by virtue of the powers vested in me under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, **I, ANTONIO V. MARIANO**, Municipal Mayor of Marcos, Ilocos Norte, do hereby order to organize the municipal Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) coordinating board of the Municipality of Marcos, Ilocos Norte and order the following:

SECTION 1. COMPOSITION OF THE MUNICIPAL CBMS COORDINATING BOARD. The Municipal CBMS Coordinating Board shall be composed of the following:
