



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 034

REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (MDC) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARCOS, ILOCOS NORTE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act 7160, known as the Local Government Code of 1991 states that the Municipal Development Council (MDC) shall formulate medium term and annual public investment programs and assist the Sanggunian in setting the direction of economic and social development and coordinating development efforts within its territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 107 and 108 of the aforementioned Republic Act provides the composition of the Municipal Development Council;

WHEREAS, due to the reorganization of chairman and members of the regular and standing committees of the Sangguniang Bayan as the result of the 2022 National and Local Elections, there is a need to reorganize the composition of the Municipal Development Council and the Executive Committee;

WHEREFORE, by virtue of powers vested in me by law, I, **ANTONIO V. MARIANO** Municipal Mayor of Marcos, Ilocos Norte, do hereby order the reorganization of the Municipal Development Council of Marcos, Ilocos Norte.

Section 1. COMPOSITION. The Municipal Development Council shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. FUNCTIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL. The Municipal Development Council shall have the following functions:

- a. Formulate long-term, medium-term and annual socio-economic development plans and policies;
- b. Formulate the medium term and annual public investment programs,
- c. Appraise and prioritize socioeconomic development programs and projects,
- d. Formulate the local investment incentives to promote the inflow directions of private investment capital;
- e. Coordinate, monitor, and evaluate the implementation of development programs and projects, and
- f. Perform such other functions may be provided by law or competent authority.

Section 3. MEETINGS. The MDC shall meet at least once every six (6) months or as often as may be necessary.

Section 4. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. The MDC shall create an executive committee to represent in behalf of the council when it is not in session. The Executive Committee (ExeCom) shall be composed of the following:

Section 5. FUNCTIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. The Executive Committee shall have the following functions:

- a. Ensure that the decisions of the MDC are faithfully carried out and implemented;
- b. Act on matters that need immediate attention and action of the MDC;
- c. Formulate policies, plans, and programs based on the objectives and priorities set by the MDC, and
- d. Take action on matters that may be authorized by the council

Section 6. SECTORAL AND FUNCTIONAL COMMITTEES. The MDC shall reconstitute the sectoral and functional committees to assist the council in the performance of their functions and shall be composed of the following:

Section 7. FUNCTIONS OF THE SECTORAL COMMITTEE. The Sectoral Committee shall have the following functions:

- a. Provide the MDC with data and information essential to the formulation of plans, programs, and projects;
- b. Define sectoral or functional objectives, set targets and identify programs and projects for the particular sector or function;
- c. Collate and analyze information and statistics and conduct related studies;
- d. Conduct public hearings on vital issues affecting the sector or function;
- e. Coordinate planning, programming and implementation of programs, projects and activities within each sector;
- f. Monitor and evaluate programs and projects; and
- g. Perform such other functions as may be assigned by the MDC.

Section 8. SECRETARIAT. The secretariat shall provide technical and administrative support, document proceedings, preparing of reports and providing such other assistance to the MDC. The Secretariat of the MDC shall be headed by the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator, **Donna Bless A. Issac** and all staff under the Office as members of the Secretariat and **Ms. Ruena Rosquita** of DepEd Elementary as Secretariat Member.

Section 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. All executive orders, proclamations, rules, regulations, previous issuances or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this order are hereby repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

Section 10. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive order shall take effect immediately.
