B. COMPLETELY NO MASS GATHERING WILL BE ALLOWED. No parties, birthday celebrations with invited guests and no religious and traditional services which entail the physical gathering of the people from two (2) or more households.

C. ACCESS TO ESSENTIAL NEEDS. Access to essential needs must be arranged by alternative means by requesting the Punong Barangay, Kagawad or other Barangay Officials in the different strategic checkpoints to purchase supplies on their behalf and to be delivered to requesting households.

Section 2. Duration. This order shall be in effect for fourteen (14) days starting immediately upon signing.

Section 3. Penalties. All persons found violating the provisions of this order shall be subjected to administrative sanctions, without prejudice to prosecution of criminal action(s), if probable cause exists.

Section 4. Enforcement. All Barangay Officials, the Municipal Police Station and Barangay Health Emergency Response Team (BHERT) and other duly delegated enforcers are hereby mandated to ensure compliance to the full extent and execution of this executive order.

Section 5. Repealing Clause. All executive orders, proclamations, rules, regulations, previous issuances or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

Section 6. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.

AN ORDER DECLARING LOCKDOWN AND CONTAINMENT OF BARANGAY SANTIAGO, MARCOS, ILOCOS NORTE.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates the Local Government Units to, among others promote the health and safety of their constituents;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte through Proclamation No. 922 s. 2020, declared a state of public health emergency due to the rapid proliferation of COVID-19 in the country;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Executive Order No. 112 authorized Mayors to impose lockdown of Barangays or part thereof, within their territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, there is a need to impose lockdown and containment of the said barangay to facilitate contact tracing purposes and to prevent the further spread of the COVID-19;

WHEREFORE, premises considered and by virtue of the powers vested in me under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, **I, ANTONIO V. MARIANO**, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Marcos, Ilocos Norte, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. LOCKDOWN AND CONTAINMENT OF BARANGAY SANTIAGO, MARCOS, ILOCOS NORTE

All ingress and egress roads going and out of the said area shall be closed and barricaded by the Philippine National Police in coordination with Barangay Officials concerned. Checkpoints shall be established by the concerned barangay in major ingress and egress shall be established by the PNP to ensure that there will be unnecessary entry of people, non-residents and other vehicles coming outside the affected area.

A.MANDATORY HOME QUARANTINE. All residents of the affected barangay during the effectivity of this order shall stay at home except:

- Those which require medical attention and one companion such as patients undergoing dialysis, cancer patients and other emergency patients are allowed to attend to their medical necessities;
- Health workers residing in the said areas except identified contact;
- Officers of the PNP, AFP and other government workers rendering emergency frontline service except identified contact;
- Service workers who are working in pharmacies, drug stores and death care services except identified contact;
- Barangay Officials of the affected barangay except identified contact;
