



**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 039**  
Series of 2022

**REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (MDRRMC) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARCOS, ILOCOS NORTE**

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the state to uphold the people's constitutional rights to life and property by addressing the root causes of vulnerabilities to disasters, risk reduction and management, and building the resilience of local communities to disasters including climate change impacts;

WHEREAS, under Section 468 (a)(1)(iv) of the Local Government Code (RA 7160), the Municipal Government must adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the municipality from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disaster and calamities;

WHEREAS, Section 11 of said law provides for the organization of the local government level of the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, and accordingly, the existing Municipal Disaster Coordinating Council (MDCC) under PD 1566 shall henceforth be known as Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC);

WHEREAS, the MDRRMC must be reorganized to replace members who no longer represent their office and due to the reorganization of the regular or standing committee of the Sangguniang Bayan Office as a result of the May 2022 National and Local Elections.

**WHEREFORE**, premises considered and by virtue of the powers vested in me under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, **I, ANTONIO V. MARIANO**, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Marcos, Ilocos Norte, do hereby reorganize the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC) and order the following:

**Section 1. Composition.** – The Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC) shall be composed of the following:

**Section 2.** Functions. The MDRRMC shall have the following functions pursuant to RA 10121:


1. Approve, monitor, and evaluate the implementation of the Municipal DRRM Plan and regularly review, test and develop the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;
2. Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs, and budgets as a strategy for sustainable development and poverty reduction;
3. Recommend the implementation of the forced or pre-emptive evacuation of local residents, if necessary; and
4. Convene the local council once every three months or as necessary.

**Section 3.** Secretariat. The LDRRMO and the Office of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development shall serve as the Secretariat of the Council.

**Section 4.** Repealing Clause. All executive orders, proclamations, rules, regulations, previous issuances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed, amended, and modified accordingly.

**Section 5.** Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
