EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 041 Series of 2022

REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL PROJECT MONITORING COMMITTEE (PMC) OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF MARCOS, ILOCOS NORTE

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 376 s. 1989 as amended by Executive Order No. 93 s. 1993 mandates the creation of a Project Monitoring Committee (RPMC) at the municipal level to facilitate project implementation and develop facilitation, problem solving, monitoring and evaluation of foreign, national and locally funded projects;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) has issued Memorandum Circular No. 2004-78 dated June 22, 2004, enjoining the Local Government Units to organize, reactivate or reconstitute the local PMCs in their respective areas of jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the Local Project Monitoring Committee is necessary for the monitoring, evaluation, and formulation of recommendations on the implementation of development plans and programs in the municipality;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reorganize the Municipal Project Monitoring Committee due to the reorganization of the regular/standing committee of the Sangguniang Bayan Members as the result of the National and Local Elections held last May 2022;

WHEREFORE, premises considered and by virtue of the powers vested in me under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, I, ANTONIO V. MARIANO, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Marcos, Ilocos Norte, do hereby amend Section 1 of Executive Order No. 019 series of 2022:

Section 1. Composition. The Municipal Project Monitoring Committee shall be composed of the following:

Section 2. Functions. The Municipal Project Monitoring Committee shall have the following functions:

- 1. Prepare monitoring plans before the end of the current year as a basis for regular monitoring of the succeeding year;
- 2. Schedule regular project field visits/inspections for a particular reporting period;
- 3. Conduct an initial appraisal of projects to be monitored based on information from monitoring;
- 4. Coordinate/establish linkage with project implementers to ensure timely submission of reports, the accuracy of project evaluation, and ensure their cooperation and active participation throughout the monitoring process;
- 5. Analyze project/activity accomplishment reports and project exception reports submitted;

- 6. Conduct regular ocular inspections at project sites;
- 7. Report findings and recommendations to Municipal Development Council or its ExCom for deliberations/resolutions/actions; and
- 8. Upon project completion, conduct a post-evaluation of selected projects.

Section 3. Repealing Clause. All executive orders, proclamations, rules, regulations, previous issuances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed, amended, and modified accordingly.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
