

**EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 002**  
**Series of 2023**

**AN ORDER ORGANIZING THE RETOOLED COMMUNITY SUPPORT PROGRAM (RCSP) TEAM AND CORE TEAM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MARCOS, LOCOS NORTE**

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Executive Order No. 70 last December 2018 entitled "Institutionalizing the Whole-of-Nation approach" in attaining inclusive and sustainable peace, creating the National Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict, and directing the adoption of a National Peace Framework;

**WHEREAS**, the Community Support Program (CSP) is a program of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) Development Support and Security Plan (DSSP) dubbed as "Kapayapaan," which is a multi-stakeholder and community-based peace and development effort aimed to establish and protect a conflict-affected community, the CSP seeks to identify issues in the communities and introduce developmental interventions to resolve these issues. However, the CSP is limited with resources in addressing issues and gaps due to limited resources and participation of other National Government Agencies (NGA);

**WHEREAS**, the Retooled Community Support Program (RCSP) is an inclusive program that aims to address identified issues of the community by closing the governance and development gaps through the provision of needed government PPAs while ensuring that development is sustained and peace is being promoted;

**WHEREAS**, the RCSP is a convergence mechanism for LGUs, particularly in the barangay, to identify issues and needed government interventions, which is anchored on the empowerment framework that intends to develop people's capability to organize themselves and own development by bringing about value-chain interventions to uplift their current condition;

**WHEREAS**, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2019-169 provides guidelines for implementing the Retooled Community Support Program (RCSP);

**WHEREFORE, I, RHONEL ALLAN M. COLOMA, Acting Municipal Mayor** of Marcos, Ilocos Norte, by the powers vested in me by law, do hereby organize the Retooled Community Support Program (RCSP) Team and Core Team of the Municipality of Marcos, Ilocos Norte as follows;

**Section 1. Composition.** The RCSP Team of the Municipality of Marcos shall be composed of the following:

## Municipal Development Council and Municipal Peace and Order Council (MDC and MPOC).

The MDC and MPOC shall maintain a vital linkage to the RCSP Task Team for programs and project coordination. The Councils shall focus on screening the prioritizing needed government interventions that must be included as a priority in the Local Development Investment Program (LDIP). Furthermore, the RCSP Team must also ensure the identified PPAs shall be implemented by securing available funding under all available sources from both national and local government resources.

**Section 2. Functions.** The Retooled Community Support Program (RCSP) Team shall have the following functions.

**RCSP Head.** The Local Chief Executive (LCE) shall serve as the HEAD of the Task Team and shall champion the cause to be at the forefront of the stride of bringing the needed government interventions to the people through RCSP. The Head shall also be in charge of deploying the RSCP Team to the target barangay for immersion and ensuring that development initiatives are appropriately addressed, and that long-term needs are properly programmed for funding and implementation.

**Basic Service Delivery Team.** The BSDT is the team tasked to serve as the primary bridge of the RCSP Team to the National Government. The configuration and additional membership of the BSDT, from Regional ELCAC Technical Working Group (TWG) Lines of Efforts (LOE) and other concerned agencies that may be identified as deemed necessary, shall be determined by the RCSP Core Team and shall depend upon the issues identified by the community during the profiling and/or based on the results of Social Investigation Class Analysis (SICA), data from Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS), Governance Audit Report (GAR), Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Systems (GIDS), information from previous CSP immersion, among others.

**Citizenship and Community Participation Team (CCPT).** The CCPT is the Team tasked to organize the Citizenship Movement by mobilizing communities into sectoral groups and ushering them to participate in all sectoral dialogues/solution-seeking tables aimed at validating the governance and development gaps of communities and identifying the needed government interventions to address them.

**Peace, Law Enforcement, and Development Support Team (PLEDS).** The PLEDS Team is tasked to conduct clearing operations one week prior to the actual send-off of the RCSP Team and ensure perimeter security of target Barangays to ensure the safety of the RCSP Team during the immersion; the Team must also heed all the advice of the AFP about security protocols including proper approach and withdrawal, to and from the barangay, during and after the immersion.

**Retooled Community Support Programs (RSCP) Core Team.** The RCSP Core Team shall serve as the unit that directly provides all the necessary tactical, technical, logistical,






and administrative assistance to the LCE in performing its functions as the RCSP Head. Once all target barangays for the year are identified, and the respective RCSP teams are identified and organized, the RCSP Core Team shall undergo RCSP training and simulation exercises before the send-off ceremony and actual immersion. Local Government Academy shall spearhead the training in partnership with the DILG Regional Office.

**Section 3.** Repealing Clause. All executive orders, proclamations, rules, regulations, previous issuances, or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Order are hereby repealed, amended, and modified accordingly.

**Section 4.** Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
